EMPLOY THESE BEST PRACTICES AND INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF LANDING A UN JOB BY OPTIMISING YOUR APPLICATION:

5 THINGS CANDIDATES SHOULD DO TO STAND OUT WITH THEIR JOB APPLICATION:

- A well-written CV is a must: avoid spelling mistakes or bad grammar. If you can, get someone to proofread your CV before sending it through.
- 2. Only include key information related to your experience and skills for the job being advertised.
- Exclude information which makes your CV unnecessarily long, such as height, weight, religion, skin colour, and other irrelevant personal information.
- 4. Use bullet points instead of long paragraphs of text.
- 5. Make sure the formatting of your CV is simple and easy read.
- 6. Include a maximum of 2 direct line managers as references (with up-to-date contact details).

HOW TO OPTIMISE YOUR APPLICATION TO THE SPECIFIC JOB ADVERTISEMENT:

- Only apply for roles that closely match your experience.
- Make sure you have addressed any essential qualifications, requirements, and competencies of the job in your CV (NB do not copy/paste specs from the ad).
- Follow 'How to apply' instructions.
- Include keywords and technical terminology related to the job in your application.





INSIDE TIPS FROM CTG RECRUITERS FOR JOB APPLICANTS:

- Relevant experience matching the Terms of Reference (TOR) is essential. If you don't have that your CV will not be considered.
- Don't forget to insert your contact details; we see a lot of smart candidates upload their CVs without any contact information.

3 THINGS YOU SHOULD DO ON TAYO, CTG'S HR PLATFORM, TO BE MORE EFFECTIVE WITH YOUR CTG JOB APPLICATION:

- 1. Make sure your candidate profile is 100% complete; this includes information related to education, experience, references, and contact details.
- Upload all key documents such as your CV, qualifications and certificates, passport, and other documents to your candidate profile.
- 3. Try to complete the compulsory CTG Onboarding Pass on CTG Learning as early as you can.
