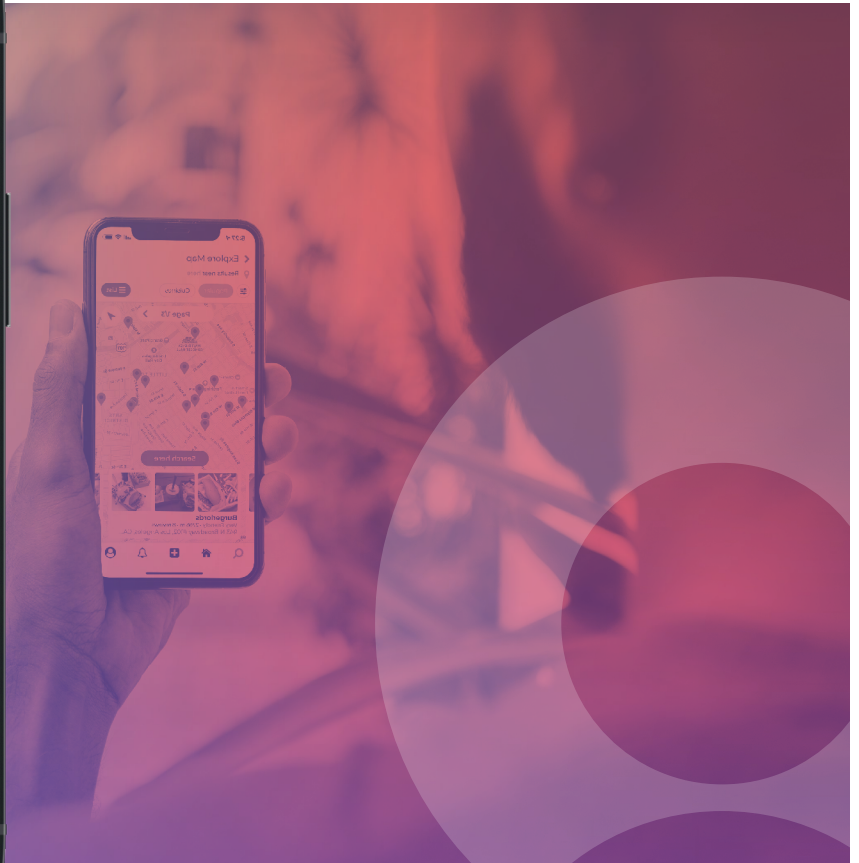
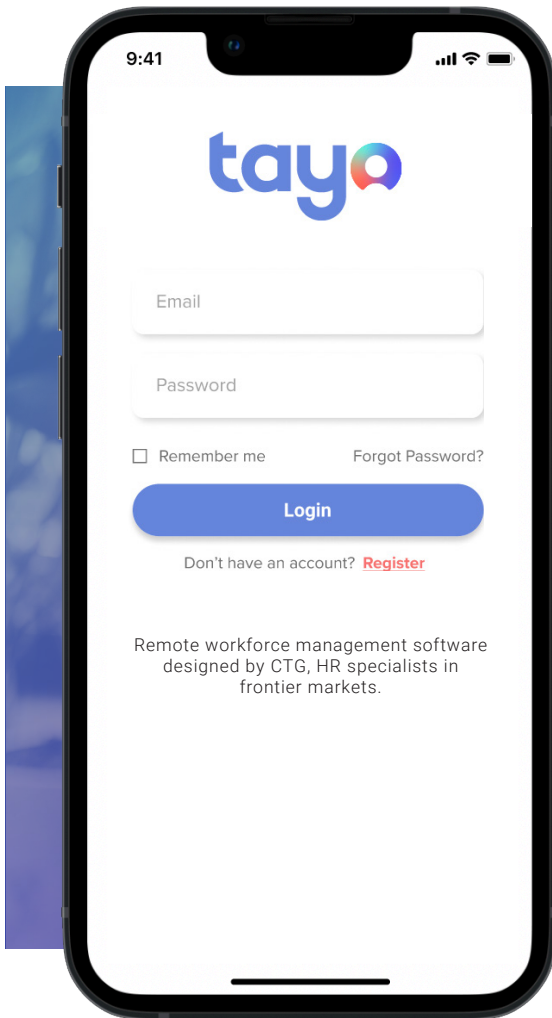

TIME & ATTENDANCE CHECK-IN:

PAIN POINTS FROM THE TYPICAL BIOMETRIC SYSTEM:

- Limited access to machines and long waiting times
- Information is recorded and stored manually on the machines meaning extra admin work
- Fingerprint recognition sometimes faulty
- Unstable internet connection

Tayo provides a robust and secure check-in functionality

Innovation and digitisation is a key priority for CTG in terms of improving and streamlining processes, which is why we tailor-made a solution to improve the check-in system, incorporating it into the Tayo app.

The check-in and check-out feature on the Tayo app is quick and secure. It provides our staff with a self-service portal to clock in or clock out wherever they may be and allows their managers to monitor their location and carry out attendance monitoring remotely.





KEY FEATURES:

With the device in their pocket, staff can check in and out anywhere



ONLINE AND OFFLINE CHECK-IN/ CHECK-OUT: The app allows our staff to clock in and out both online and offline, so that they can record their attendance even in areas with limited or no internet connectivity.



PHOTO VERIFICATION: Instead of biometric or fingerprint scanning, the app uses a photo to verify the identity of the staff and confirm that they are clocking in or out.



AUTOMATED TIME AND LOCATION TRACKING: The app automatically tracks the time and location of the check-in and check-out, so that there's no need for manual input.



ADD NOTES: Staff can add notes to their check-in and check-out to provide additional context or explanation for their attendance (optional).



ADMIN MONITORING: The app allows administrators to monitor attendance and view reports on employee attendance and work hours. They can also reach out to staff to clarify any issues or discrepancies.
